PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

A Compressor Operator is responsible for operating and maintaining gas compressor units, gas processing equipment, accessories and auxiliary equipment without direct supervision. Makes necessary changes in gas line operations. Document and maintain all necessary operating/maintenance and repair records and submit reports. In addition, the compressor operator will also be responsible for:

- Keeping machinery, equipment, building, walkways and surroundings clean
- Making minor repairs and adjustments to machines and accessories
- Assisting with major repairs or overhauls to machinery
- Reporting all unusual circumstances to supervisor immediately
- Performing other varied gas field activities including installation, repairs and maintenance of gas well equipment and pipeline systems
- Performing other field work when not attending compressor stations

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Valid driver's license
- The physical capability to work outdoors in all types of weather and in and around hazards and difficult to reach areas is required.
- Strong mechanical aptitude and the ability to troubleshoot technical issues
- Excellent customer service/communication skills
- Basic literacy is required. Ability to read, legibly prepare written documentation and have the ability to accurately interpret and analyze written information
- Basic computer skills
- Equivalent work experience, mechanic experience, engine repair or troubleshooting, and installation/repair of pneumatic and electrical equipment is preferred.
